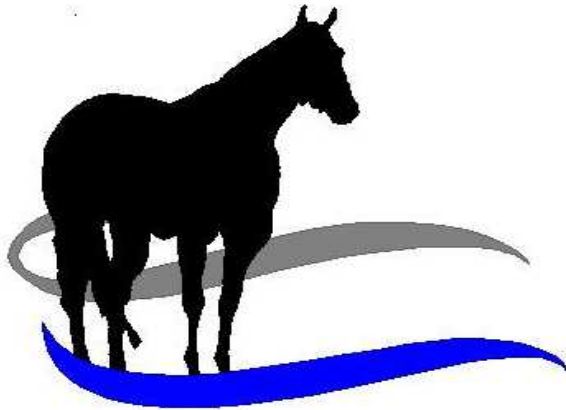

SUPER HORSE

ENTRY FEE - \$75

PRIZE MONEY \$1,000.00 Plus trophy buckle and Garland to 1st place.

The super horse is conducted over 5 legs – Halter, Hunter Under Saddle, Trail, Western Pleasure & Reining. To be eligible for awards, horses must contest all legs. Horses entered may have a max of two horse handlers. Awards will be given for the highest placed Youth & Amateur. However the horse must be ridden or handled by the Youth & Amateur in all legs. Scoring will be as follows: 1st 10 Points, 2nd 9 Points down to 10th 1 Point. Only Horses placed (1st-10th) in each leg will be scored.

DEBUTANTE TWO YEAR OLD WESTERN PLEASURE SHOWCASE

To be eligible to compete in the Debutante 2 Year Old Western Pleasure Showcase, your horse must not have been shown under saddle in any ridden event at any approved or unapproved show prior to this event.

The horse entered may not be entered into any event at the Australian Halter Showcase that is scheduled to be run prior to the final of the Debutante Western Pleasure. Awards will be given to the highest placed Amateur & Youth.

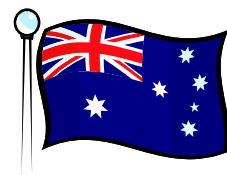

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries close the 3rd of February 2012. Late entries will incur a \$20 office fee per class.
2. Signing of an entry form binds the Owner/Competitor of the agreement of the conditions of entry & Competition as printed in the show schedule. Parent or guardian must sign youth Entries.
3. The Australian Halter Showcase Committee, Show Staff & Werribee Park Management will not be held responsible for any accident sickness to any horse, owner, rider, handler or competitor, spectator or property. Horses and those in attendance at the show, do so at their own risk. There will be a compulsory temporary membership charge of \$15.00 for every non-AQHA member competing.
4. The AQHA Statement on Animal Welfare will be posted and adhered to. All horses, irrespective of breed, will be treated in a humane manner. Show management has the right to remove any persons causing interference to others.
5. Swabs may be taken and the AQHA protocol for drug testing applies. If a Horse owner or person responsible for that horse refuses a drug test on request, then that horse will be scratched from further competition and the breed association will be notified of the incident.
6. There will be no lunging in the indoor arena by order of Werribee Park Management (Except for Yearling on the Lunge event warm up prior to the start of this event). Training equipment of any kind will not be used in the arena one hour before the show begins to one hour after the show concludes
7. Protests must be lodged in writing with \$50.00 payment. Protests will only be considered up to one hour after the classes or incident.
8. Show management has the right to change the order of the program, however full notice will be given. If there are insufficient entries in any event, show management reserves the right to cancel the event.
9. The Australian Quarter Horse Association Rules & Regulations will apply to both competition and in the running of the show. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be familiar with these Rules & Regulations. All reining events are run under AQHA rules.
10. All prize money is guaranteed and will be paid to fourth place. All prize money will be paid by cheque.
11. 'Catch Rider' may be used if one person qualifies two horses in go-rounds for SHOWCASE events.
12. Top 10 horses will proceed to finals. If insufficient entries, go rounds will not be necessary.
13. Competitors/participants at any event run by the AHS have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses & at all times to treat their horses humanely & with dignity, respect & compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner & act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate & other competitors. To uphold the rules & regulations of the AHS & the AQHA at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors & officials, following the rules & to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.
14. A SELECT AMATEUR may enter a SELECT AMATEUR class once they turn 50 years of age. Eligible riders may compete in OPEN classes and either SELECT or AMATEUR at a show, but not in both Amateur categories of any one performance section. E.g. A rider choosing to enter Select trail is not permitted to also enter Amateur trail at the same show, however, the Amateur is permitted to compete in Junior or Senior horse trail. An Amateur choosing to ride Select in any category at a show (e.g. Hunter Under Saddle) is not confined to Select classes in other categories (e.g. Trail & Western Pleasure) at the same show.
15. OPEN LIMITED: A horse is ineligible for this event if it has 20 AQHA points or has won \$1500.
16. **LIMITED AMATEUR:** The criteria applies to each event individually, the amateur must not have 30 or more AA lifetime points in each event (amateur to provide proof with their applications from their relevant associations, the application will be up for consideration if, after the year 2000, the amateur has received a title in any point or feature event at the following shows – National & State Shows (any breed), NPHA, AHS, Energex Western Breeds Celebration. See AHS web site for full details – www.haltershowcase.com.au
17. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a leash. Strictly **NO DOGS IN THE ARENAS** & owners **MUST** pick up after their dogs.
18. Stable requirements – three performance classes or one showcase event to qualify as per entry form.
19. Only traders and sponsors authorized by the AHS committee are permitted to trade at the show.
20. Copies of horse registration papers, current AQHA membership & current Amateur / Select Amateur permit must be included with your entry forms. Any person with outstanding debts owed to the AHS will not be allowed to compete until all debts are cleared
21. To be eligible for any high point award, the horse must compete in a minimum of 2 events.
22. High Point awards as per AQHA rule book for High Point Performance Horse
23. **NO SMOKING IN ARENAS AS PER WPNEC rules.** Use of Dressage arenas & area to the zoo is prohibited
24. **NO HORSES ALLOWED** on grass area between barn & arena & doors to barn to be closed & horses must use back entrance.
25. Class A & B to be run under full show conditions (gear and attire) and is a non approved AQHA event.
